Thank you for requesting MOFGA Certification Services (MCS) approval for bulk compost. Based on information you have provided during our 2018 re-review we are able to make the following determination:

Bulk Compost (Country Fare, Inc.-Bowdoin, Maine) is approved for use in USDA National Organic Program (NOP) production by MOFGA Certification Services, LLC.

This approval is not an endorsement, but rather a statement of a decision that the material described meets the USDA organic standards and requirements as stated in NOP Section 205.203. Any changes to your compost production or feedstocks must be submitted and approved by MCS before the product can be marketed.

The duration of approval for compost production will be three years. Renewal of compost approval must be submitted by the compost producer to MOFGA Certification Services at the end of the three- year period. All products for which approval in certified organic production is sought must be included in the application.

Composts or soil mixes must not be labeled or advertised as certified organic, and MOFGA's certified organic logo may not be used to market the product. Use of MOFGA' s name or its organizational logo may be permitted, but only after written approval by MOFGA for a specific phrase or graphic.
